NOTIFICATION

Port Blair, dated the 20th December, 2010

No. 373/2010/F.No.20-1/Estt/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. 14/3/60-ANI dated the 11th April, 1960, and in supersession of Notification No. /F.No. 42- 595/2004-TR dated 27th May, 2005, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of ARTISAN GRADE-II and ASSISTANT TYRE REPAIRER borne in the establishment of the Directorate of Transport, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely:-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:-

- (i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Artisan Gr-II and Assistant Tyre Repairer in the Directorate of Transport) Recruitment Rules, 2010.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. NUMBER OF POST, CLASSIFICATION AND SCALE OF PAY:-

The number of said posts, their classification and Pay Band & Grade Pay/Scale of Pay attached thereto shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATION:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in paras 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. DISQUALIFICATION:-

No persons -

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. POWER TO RELAX :

Where the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

6. SAVING :

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Duties & Responsibilities of Assistant Tyre Repairer

1. To carry out all types of Tyre Repairing works related to repair and maintenance works in the light as well as Heavy Motor Vehicles under the Motor Transport Department in A & N Administration.
2. To assist the Tyre Repairer in carrying out the responsibilities of a workshop under the Motor Transport Department.
3. To perform all skilled as well as unskilled nature of works related to Tyre Repairing in the workshop.
4. Assistant Tyre Repairer shall be responsible for the smooth running of the Tyre Repairing works in the absence of Tyre Repairer.
5. Assistant Tyre Repairer shall undertake all other works as entrusted by his superiors.
