The competent authority has been pleased to introduce the scheme of concessional AC Bus Passes for Senior Citizen/Students/general commuters in AC Buses operated by State Transport Service of Transport Department, A & N administration with immediate effect. Fares of concessional AC Bus Passes and its terms and condition are as follows:

SL No.	Category	One Month Fare
1	Senior Citizen (Above 80 years)	FREE
	Senior Citizen (Above 60 Years but below 80 Years)	₹565/-
2	Students	₹565/-
3	General Commuters	₹900/-

Terms and Conditions:

1. The holder of Bus pass shall be permitted to travel in AC buses and ordinary STS buses having a maximum route length of 50 KMs, in any part of A&N Islands. However, in tribal area of Nicobar District, validity of passes will be subjected to the fulfillment of requirements of PAT regulations.
2. The Bus Pass is valid only for two journeys in a day in AC Buses operated by STS Department and there will be no restriction on the number of journeys in non AC ordinary buses.
3. The concessional bus pass shall be issued to students on payment basis on production of recognized school/ institution ID proof.
4. Applications for concessional passes should be made in the prescribed format, (Annexure- I) along with one spare stamp size (15mm X 15mm) photograph and the fare prescribed above to the controlling & supervising officer of the respective STS unit.

This has been done to facilitate the general commuters and to attract general people towards public transport. The fares of concessional Bus Passes and its terms and condition are as follows:

Terms and Conditions:
